Frances Arricale is the Executive Director of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission (“IIPRC”). Named to the post in December 2006, Arricale is responsible for managing the day-to-day operations of the IIPRC. With the successful start-up of the IIPRC product filing operations in 2007, Arricale manages the development and implementation of necessary policies, procedures, and control measures for its streamlined, national product review processes; oversees its public notice platforms and state outreach; and provides reports to the IIPRC Management Committee.

Arricale joined the Commission after having served as Associate Deputy Commissioner and General Counsel for the New York City Commission to the United Nations, Consular Corps and Protocol in the Office of the Mayor. In this capacity, she worked on behalf of the City as liaison to the United Nations and handled international legal matters.

Prior to this position, Arricale was a Corporate Vice President in the Government Affairs Office of New York Life Insurance Company. During her time based in New York City and Washington, D.C., she managed a portfolio of domestic and international insurance regulatory matters, as well as global financial services and trade issues. Arricale also had served as a regulatory compliance officer for the U.S. Department of Education.

Arricale is an attorney licensed in New York, California and Washington, D.C. She is a graduate of Fordham University and Brooklyn Law School. Additionally, Arricale completed certificate study at the Government Affairs Institute of Georgetown University; as well as legal study in European Community Law on fellowship in Brussels, Belgium and in Public International Law at The Hague Academy of International Law in the Netherlands. She is a member of the American Bar Association, as well as several local bar associations.
