Submissions for Industry Advisory Committee Now Being Accepted
*** Four (4) Appointments for Two-Year Term ***

The initial four (4) appointments for two-year terms on the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission (IIPRC) Industry Advisory Committee will expire at the 2009 IIPRC Annual Meeting on September 21, 2009. Nominations and applications are now being accepted for four (4) new appointments to two-year terms on the Industry Advisory Committee. Under the *IIPRC Bylaws*, after the initial appointments, the Committee will now have eight (8) seats of staggering two-year terms. A copy of the *IIPRC Bylaws* may be located on the IIPRC web site. The Industry Advisory Committee is to be comprised of insurers, producer and industry organizations. Industry organizations should represent members that have an expressed interest in using the Commission for making product filings, and an insurer should express their intent to utilize the Commission to file applicable insurance products.

Persons interested in serving on the Industry Advisory Committee should submit information to Karen Schutter, the Executive Director of the IIPRC which demonstrates his or her expertise and interest in serving on the Industry Advisory Committee including:

- a. A statement of interest.
- b. A resume or description of background including employment and education experience.
- c. A copy of the industry organization's bylaws reflecting the organization's mission and purpose.
- d. A statement of the premium volume of business of the insurer or producer.
- e. A statement of the nominee's (or its members') intent to utilize the Commission to file applicable insurance products
