



Submissions for Consumer Advisory Committee Now Being Accepted

The Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission (IIPRC) is continuing to accept applications for its Consumer Advisory Committee. The committee is comprised of eight (8) members.

The Consumer Advisory Committee is to be comprised of persons representing national, state or local consumer non-profit organizations with a membership of at least 25 members. Persons interested in serving on the Consumer Advisory Committee should submit information to Frances Arricale, the Executive Director of the IIPRC which demonstrates his or her expertise and interest in serving on the Consumer Advisory Committee including:

- a. A statement of interest.
- b. A resume or description of background including employment and education experience.
- c. A copy of the consumer non-profit organization's bylaws reflecting the organization's mission and purpose.
- d. A general description of the consumer non-profit organization's source of funding
- e. A statement that the person and the consumer non-profit organization are independent of any insurance industry interests.
