Prior to joining the IIPRC, Maureen was a member of the New Hampshire Insurance Department (“NHID”) from 1989 to 2010 where she was the Life and Health Compliance Manager. Her responsibilities included hiring, training and supervision of life and health insurance examiners along with other division employees. Maureen was involved in the transformation of the NHID from paper and typewriters to all product filings and fees being received electronically through the SERFF system. She implemented division procedures for the review of policy forms and monitoring the application of these procedures by division personnel to ensure uniformity.

Maureen has been active in the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (“NAIC”) Committees and Working Groups including Speed to Market Task Force, Vice Chair of Operational Efficiencies Working Group, a member of the SERFF Board of Directors and currently serving as an ex-officio member, State Chair of the SERFF Product Steering Committee and an active participant of the IIPRC Product Steering Committee.

Prior the NHID Maureen worked for eleven years in the insurance industry. Her responsibilities included traveling to various life agencies and disability brokerage offices across the country to train new managers in corporate procedures, accounting and software programs.

She is a Certified Public Manager (CPM), Health Insurance Associate (HIA), and a member of the Association of Insurance Compliance Professionals (AICP) and the Insurance Regulatory Examiners Society (IRES).
