



## IIPRC IS NOW ACCEPTING 2012 ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEES

*Avoid Disruption and Register Early*

It's that time of year! The Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission (IIPRC) is accepting 2012 Annual Registration Fees. Companies paying their IIPRC Annual Registration Fee on or before January 1, 2012 can continue to file without disruption.

Register and experience the benefits of preparing one product filing through the Compact for review and approval on behalf of 41 members – 40 states and Puerto Rico. By filing with the IIPRC, companies receive the added value of eliminating state-by-state content variations and reducing duplicative paperwork, processes and systems implementations all with an approval in an average 60 review days or less.

The excitement continues at the IIPRC with New Jersey, Illinois, Alabama and Nevada accepting Compact filings in 2011 and Oregon accepting Compact filings as of January 18, 2012. Registered companies were able to file individual long-term care and combination product filings in 2011 and now will be able to make individual disability income product filings starting January 12, 2012. With 82 adopted Uniform Standards, companies can file a wide and complete array of individual asset-based products through the IIPRC.

Be one of the efficiency-minded companies to take advantage of the IIPRC's straightforward filing process, which includes prompt, easy access to a professional team of product reviewers and actuaries who will work with companies before and after a filing is made to answer questions and provide guidance for compliance. Take advantage of the many tools offered to filing companies including detailed uniform standards, reviewer checklists, on-demand, web-based tutorials, and streamlined payment of state filing fees. Use the unique mix-and-match and add-a-state features to accommodate product development needs.

As noted in the Terms and Procedures for IIPRC Filing Fees, the IIPRC Annual Registration Fee is due at the start of the calendar year. All filers must register in order to utilize the IIPRC's one-stop filing platform. The Annual Registration Fee is \$5,000. Companies filing in 12 or fewer states can take advantage of the IIPRC's Regional Registration Fee of \$2,500.
