## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

**Proposed Rule**: Amendments to the Rule for Adoption, Amendment and Repeal of Rules of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission

- 1. **Purpose of Proposed New Rules**: The purpose of the proposed amendments to the Rule for Adoption, Amendment and Repeal of Rules of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission is to add a new provision for Direct Final Rule for the adoption of noncontroversial rules, as detailed in §110.
- 2. **Legal Authority**: The Commission is authorized to create rules and operating procedures by Article IV, Sections 1 and 6 of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Compact, as enacted into law by each compacting state.
- 3. **Text of Proposed New Rules**: The proposed amendments are available on the Commission's web site (www.insurancecompact.org) and included with this notice as a separate document.
- 4. Where, When, and How Persons May Present Their Views: The Management Committee for the Commission will accept written comment on the proposed amendments until October 27, 2025. - 5. Where, When, and How Persons May Request a Public Hearing: Written requests for a public hearing on the proposed amendments must be received no later than September 16, 2025. Persons who may request a public hearing are Commission members, the Management Committee, the Legislative Committee, the Consumer Advisory Committee, the Industry Advisory Committee, or a person or organization representing at least 25 persons affected by the proposed amendments.
