NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

**Date Issued:** August 27, 2025

**Proposed Rule:** Amendments to the Rule for Adoption, Amendment and Repeal of Rules of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission

1. **Purpose of Proposed New Rules:** The purpose of the proposed amendments to the Rule for Adoption, Amendment and Repeal of Rules of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission is to add a new provision for Direct Final Rule for the adoption of non-controversial rules, as detailed in §110.
2. **Legal Authority:** The Commission is authorized to create rules and operating procedures by Article IV, Sections 1 and 6 of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Compact, as enacted into law by each compacting state.
3. **Text of Proposed New Rules:** The proposed amendments are available on the Commission's web site ([www.insurancecompact.org](http://www.insurancecompact.org)) and included with this notice as a separate document.
4. **Where, When, and How Persons May Present Their Views:** The Management Committee for the Commission will accept written comment on the proposed amendments until **October 27, 2025**. 5. **Where, When, and How Persons May Request a Public Hearing:** Written requests for a public hearing on the proposed amendments must be received no later than **September 16, 2025**. Persons who may request a public hearing are Commission members, the Management Committee, the Legislative Committee, the Consumer Advisory Committee, the Industry Advisory Committee, or a person or organization representing at least 25 persons affected by the proposed amendments.
