**SUBJECT:** Uniform Standards Identification List for 2026 with Suggested Priorities

The system for the identification and prioritization of new, or amendments to, Uniform Standards is an annual process. This process allows input by Interested Parties, including Commissioners, Regulators, Legislators, Consumer Representatives, Insurers, Legislative Committee, Consumer Advisory Committee, Industry Advisory Committee, and the Compact Office.

Through the annual process, Compact members can determine if the prioritization of Uniform Standards development is aligned with the organization's strategic initiatives and incorporate any implications to the operating revenues or expenses of the organization in the budget planning process.

Interested Parties can request new or amended standards by using the form on the <u>Product Standards Committee (PSC) page</u> of the Compact website. Requests that were received by June 30, 2025, are found on the <u>Standards page</u> of the Compact website.

The PSC reviewed and prepared a list of the requests it received. The PSC held a public call on August 5, 2025, to receive comments on the list of requests and the carryover items from 2025. The PSC considered the comments during regulator-only calls on August 19<sup>th</sup> and September 9<sup>th</sup> and assigned suggested priorities to the requests. The PSC is holding this second public call to receive comments and feedback on the suggested priorities. The PSC will review the comments and finalize the list for referral to the Management Committee.

The PSC will accept written comments on the Uniform Standards Identification List for 2026 with Suggested Priorities until October 3, 2025.
