NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

Date issued: March 31, 2026

Proposed Operating Procedure: Operating Procedure for the Intermediate Review of the Application of Uniform Standards or Operating Procedures During the Review of a Product Filing Submission

- 1. Purpose of Proposed Operating Procedure:** The purpose of the proposed operating procedure is to provide filers a new course of action by which an insurance company filer may obtain a second, authoritative opinion regarding interpretation of the Uniform Standards used to review the insurance company's product during Compact review.
- 2. Legal Authority:** The Commission is authorized to create operating procedures by Article IV, Section 1 of the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Compact, as enacted into law by each compacting state.
- 3. Text of Proposed New Rules:** The Proposed Operating Procedure is available on the Commission's web site (www.insurancecompact.org) and included with this notice as a separate document.
- 4. Where, When, and How Persons May Present Their Views:** The Management Committee for the Commission will accept written comment on the Proposed Operating Procedure until June 1, 2026. - 5. Where, When, and How Persons May Request a Public Hearing:** Written requests for a public hearing on the Proposed Operating Procedure must be received no later than April 20, 2026. Persons who may request a public hearing are Commission members, the Management Committee, the Legislative Committee, the Consumer Advisory Committee, the Industry Advisory Committee, or a person or organization representing at least 25 persons affected by the Proposed Operating Procedure.
