### IIPRC IS NOW ACCEPTING 2010 ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEES

*Register By the End of January to Receive a 10% Discount*

It's that time of year! The Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Commission (IIPRC) is accepting 2010 Annual Registration Fees. Companies paying their IIPRC Annual Registration Fee on or before January 1, 2010 can continue to file without disruption. **The IIPRC is offering a 10% discount of \$500 off the 2010 Annual Registration Fee for companies registering by January 31, 2010.**

The IIPRC provides a central point of electronic product filing on behalf of all 36 members -- 35 states and Puerto Rico. By using the IIPRC, companies can submit one filing, under one set of uniform standards, for one review and approval in under 60 days. Companies are currently able to file products corresponding to 54 Uniform Standards including individual life and individual annuity products. In 2010, the IIPRC will continue to adopt and implement additional uniform standards for individual annuity, long-term care and disability income.

As noted in the Terms and Procedures for IIPRC Filing Fees, the IIPRC Annual Registration Fee is due at the start of the calendar year. All filers must register in order to utilize the IIPRC's one-stop filing platform. The Annual Registration Fee is \$5,000 (discounted to \$4,500 until January 31, 2010).
